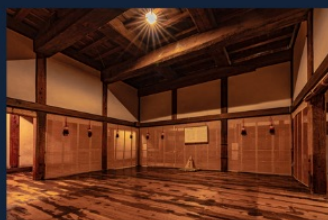

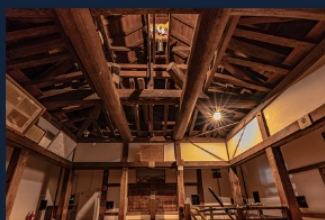

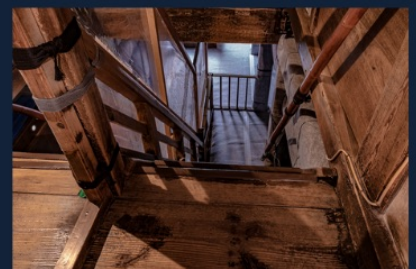
Need to Bring

PLEASE READ before Booking

- The Keep is six-story building with steep, narrow stairs and no elevator. Approximately 140 steps with a maximum slope of 61°.
- It's around 0C / 32F, the lowest temperature is nearly -5C / 23F during the night time in Matsumoto city.
- Please make sure to dress warmly and Do not forget to wear thick socks and non-slip gloves.
- The floor and handrails are very cold in the castle.

This tour requires a minimum of 7 participants to operate. If fewer than 6 participants register, the tour will be canceled, and we will notify you by email at least 5 days prior.
